RESIDENCE HALL ROOMS

The University of Puget Sound, where all sessions and special events will be held, offers single accommodations in Trimble Hall. Opened for summer guests in 2003, this is the University of Puget Sound's newest residence, and boasts the following amenities: complimentary local telephone calls and voice mail; complimentary access to our high-speed network for your computer (and complimentary access to our computer lounges if you do not bring a computer), a pillow, pillowcase, sheets, blankets, towels, washcloth and soap; daily newspaper for your suite; See's chocolates on your pillow, and a bottle of water in your room. In addition, guests are welcome to utilize the university's Fitness Center and/or indoor pool at no charge. Sports equipment is available for check out at the Conference Services office as well.
